The sheer variety of hiking trails, many of which have special themes, make the Schmitten a true hiking paradise in Pinzgau.

SALZBURG'S HIGHEST EXCURSION DESTINATION AT 3,000 METRES

THE ALPINE 3,000 METRE PEAKS HAVE THEIR VERY OWN ENERGY. There are 266 of them in the 1,800 km² Upper Tauern National Park. In addition, there are also 551 mountain lakes and 342 glaciers that captivate nature lovers all year round. Under the "patronage" of Austria's highest mountain, the Grossglockner (3,797 m), the Upper Tauern National Park manifests a quaint sense of beauty and diversity. And it's not just a Mecca for walkers and nature enthusiasts. Hiking in the National Park in summer is a true holiday highlight. Countless hiking routes throughout the entire park invite you to explore this unique nature reserve and experience its magic close up.

Anyone can reach the Gipfelwelt 3000 in comfort via cable car and enjoy an impression of high-alpine nature at 3,029 metres above sea level. An adventure that is normally only reserved for experienced mountaineers on their tours becomes a leisurely excursion at 3,000 metres on the Kitzsteinhorn. You'll enjoy magnificent views from the "Top of Salzburg" and "National Park Gallery" viewing platforms. You can experience the glacier close up while enjoying some summer sliding fun in the Ice Arena below the summit. National park rangers will guide you through the Gipfelwelt 3000 and provide interesting details on the Upper Tauern and Kitzsteinhorn.

GUIDED TOUR TO THE SUMMIT OF THE 3,203 M HIGH KITZSTEINHORN.

Experience the feeling of being at 3,000 m on a guided tour of the Kitzsteinhorn. From high up above, you'll sense the force of the high-alpine summit world and the intense feeling of freedom. Accompanied by a certified mountain guide and

secured by a rope, you'll experience your personal 3,000 metre happiness after a climb of 200 metres (approx. 1 hour).

FROM MOUNTAIN BIKES TO E-BIKES: IT'S ALL ABOUT BIKING. Zell am See also has a hugely varied playground where bikers can indulge in their favourite sport: e-bikers will quickly enjoy success while mountain bikers or trekking bikers can explore the cross-country landscape. Downhill specialists will also find three freeride trails with a total length of 16 km on the Maiskogel, Hundstein and Kitzsteinhorn. By bike is not the only way to go up the Schmittenhöhe, as you can also access the Schmittenhöhe biking paradise with bike transport for just €10. Numerous greenlevel tours invite you to really let off steam. Pedalo riders can also tackle a variety of course sections on the Tauern Cycle Path. The route from Krimml to Zell am See is particularly attractive, whereby you can also easily get to Krimml by train. The 65 km long route goes from Krimml via Neukirchen and Bramberg to Wildkogel, Mittersill, Stuhlfelden, Uttendorf and Kaprun and then back to Zell am See.

Four 18-hole courses within a few kilometres make the region a unique golf hotspot in the heart of the alpine world. As one of twelve "Leading Golf Courses" in Austria, the Golfclub Zell am See-Kaprun sets standards and invites golfers to try and achieve a hole in one. The two Schmittenhöhe and Kitzsteinhorn 18-hole courses are both demanding and creative and offer both rookies and experienced golfers alike a welcome challenge.

Our "health cuisine" contains no animal fats, sugar, white flour or cream. This means that all stocks are only sweetened with white onion and we only rely on the sweetness and taste intensity of fruits in our desserts and pastries. We use the highest quality native olive oils and other unsaturated oils when cooking and frying and thicken sauces and soups using pureed vegetables or rice. We serve lots of fish, little meat and lots of vegetables.

NEW SMALL BREWERY

Something drinkable has been brewing at the Pinzgau brewery for some time. For almost two years brewer Valentin Klien, who completed his apprenticeship at the famous Obertrum Bierkulturhaus, has been creating a range of beers in the show brewery owned by the renowned German producer Kaspar Schulz. There was so much demand that the initial weekly brewing day has now been followed by a second one. The brewing plant has a capacity of 500 litres and is filled with organic malt from Grieskirchen.

Alongside traditional cellar beer, the young brewer is also a fan of his wheat and regularly tries his hand at trendy beer styles such as pale ale. However, it's best to try them for yourselves! You can also enjoy our draught beers at the Salzburger Hof. Cheers!

Beer-related questions and answers from and with Dalentin Klien

HOW DID THE IDEA OF YOUR OWN BREWERY COME INTO BEING? My father had the idea of starting his own brewery more than 20 years ago. In 2019, we then decided to set up our hotel brewery.

HOW OFTEN DO YOU SAMPLE THE BEER DURING THE BREWING PROCESS? Before you start brewing, you always first taste the malt. This is then followed by the compulsory tasting of the last stage of the brewing process. The final highlight is tasting the beer after it's been brewed to determine its original wort.

HOW DID YOU GET INVOLVED WITH BREWING? Like probably most hobby brewers, it all started with a mini system in my kitchen at home. I had to get rid of this when the kitchen fridge quickly became a place to store the beer. Most people then move into the basement or garage. There also wasn't enough space in the hotel kitchen – so we had to find brewery premises.

WHAT'S YOUR FAVOURITE BEER, APART FROM YOUR OWN? That's a very difficult guestion, as I'd have to name at least two. On the one hand, the traditional Märzen beer from the "Bräustübl Salzburg-Mülln". On the stronger, modern side I really like the "Affenkönig" from Brew Age.

WHAT ARE THE CURRENT TRENDS IN THE (CRAFT) BEER MARKET? I think that the mega trends of health and regionality that we've seen over the past few years will continue. Lighter and non-alcoholic beers (e.g. beers with hemp extracts, beer mix drinks) but also old varieties that are back in trend. The high price increases in the areas of raw materials and energy will presumably cause beer prices to rise.

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




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
