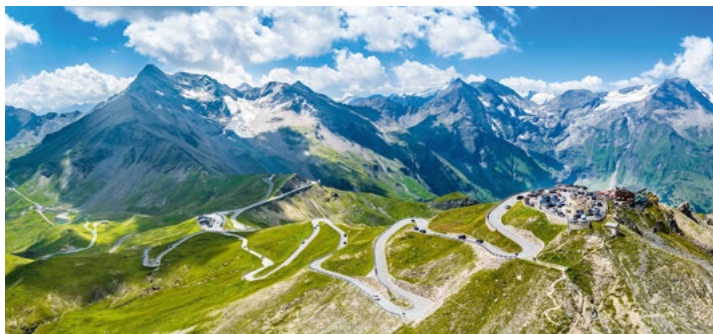

Grossglockner High Alpine Road

This famous alpine road leads to Austria's highest mountain, the Grossglockner (3,798 m). Gentle gradients and smooth curves ensure that even older engines can easily manage the ascent. Along the route, exhibitions, educational and panoramic trails, and numerous rest stops offer plenty of variety. Spectacular views of a sea of three-thousand-meter peaks and the majestic Glockner massif make the journey a delight for leisure drivers and classic car enthusiasts.



Heiligenblut

A world-famous sight, well known from photos: the proud late-Gothic church with the majestic pyramid of the Grossglockner rising in the background. This is the iconic view of Heiligenblut—and it really looks just like that. Thanks to its unique mountain backdrop, this “Glockner village” is justifiably considered one of the most beautiful mountain villages in the entire Alpine region.

Königssee

The mighty cliffs of the Berchtesgaden Alps plunge almost vertically into the shores of Lake Königssee, which reaches a depth of 192 meters at its deepest point. To truly experience the stunning natural scenery surrounding Bavaria's most beautiful mountain lake, you'll need to board a boat. The ride to the St. Bartholomä peninsula takes about 30 minutes. In addition to the baroque pilgrimage church dedicated to St. Bartholomew, visitors can explore the royal hunting lodge, which now houses a traditional Bavarian inn complete with beer garden - perfect for relaxing and taking in the view.



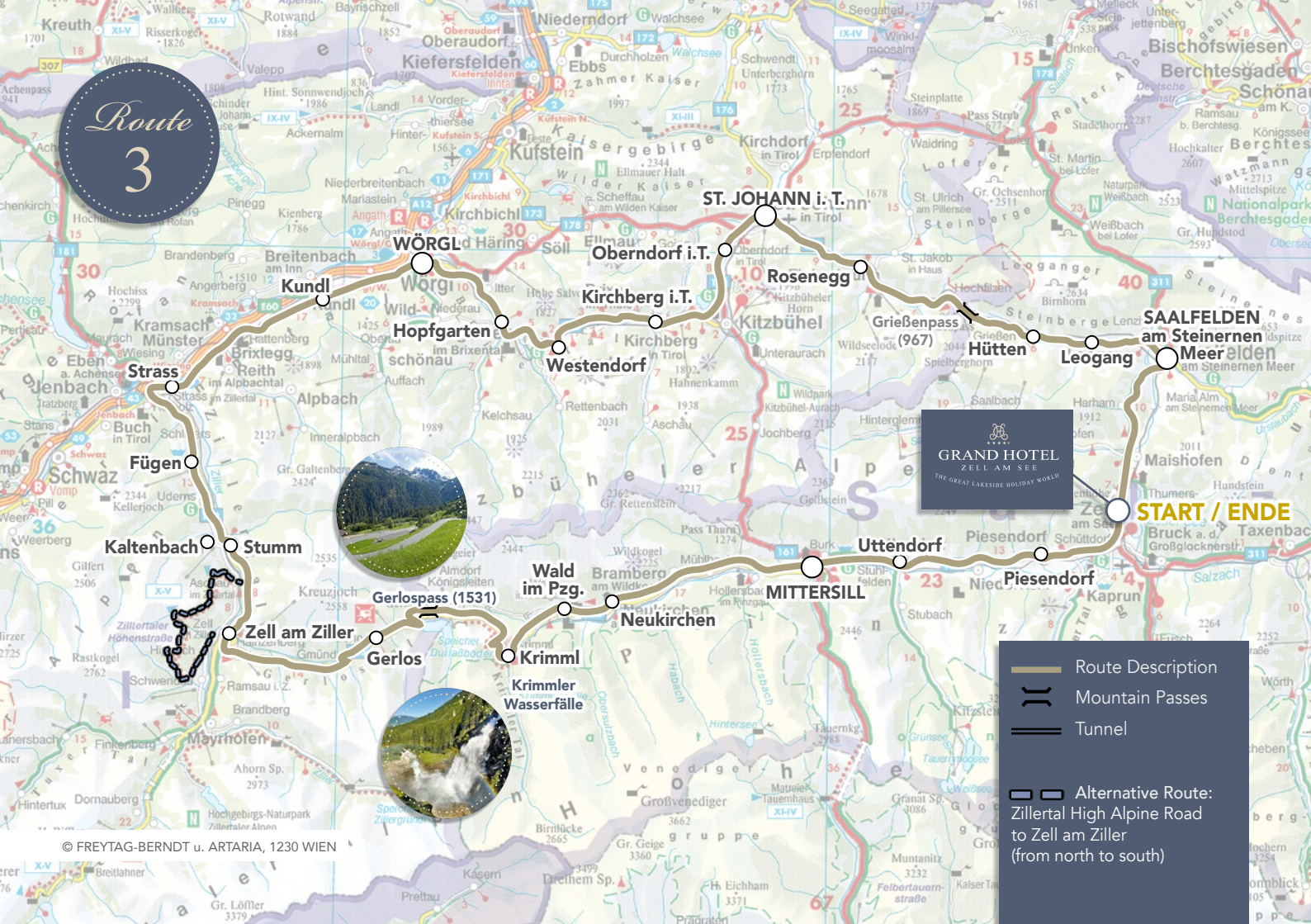
Rossfeld Panoramic Road

The Rossfeld Panoramic Road offers breathtaking views of the Alpine landscape and the Berchtesgaden region. At 1,570 meters above sea level, the toll road winds its way through impressive mountain scenery, passing green meadows and deep valleys. It's open year-round and is ideal for individual travelers by car or motorcycle. Along the route, there are numerous viewpoints and opportunities to soak in the spectacular natural beauty.

Krimml Waterfalls

The Krimml Waterfalls, the highest in Austria, offer a truly impressive natural spectacle. Across three stages, the water plunges a total of 380 meters into the depths.

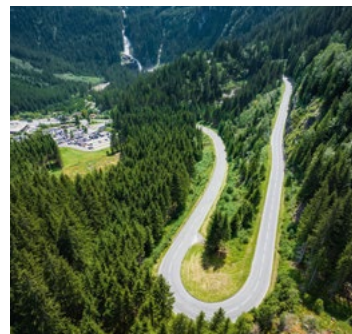

Gerlos Alpine Road

This scenic pass road in the heart of the Hohe Tauern National Park offers a wealth of opportunities for convertible and vintage car drivers, as well as nature enthusiasts. From nearly every parking area, you can catch a glimpse of the Krimml Waterfalls – and at the top of the pass, a rare high-altitude moorland awaits before the road descends to Gerlos, the first town on the Tyrolean side, and continues into the Zillertal Valley.

Lienz

Wolfgangsee

The Zwölferhorn Mountain in St. Gilgen is a year-round destination. The cable car runs in spring, summer, autumn, and winter—each season offering its own charm. The view from St. Gilgen's local mountain is uniquely beautiful and breathtaking every time. The Postalm, Austria's largest contiguous alpine pasture area, is easily accessible by car from Strobl. One of the most iconic peaks of the Salzkammergut region is the Schafberg, which can be reached by the Schafbergbahn cogwheel railway.

Hallstatt

Every year, visitors from around the world flock to Hallstatt. Its romantic alleys, cozy cafés, and numerous small shops offering souvenirs for those back home invite guests to linger. A must-see is the Hallstatt Museum, which—alongside the Natural History Museum in Vienna - houses the second largest collection of Hallstatt-period artifacts in Austria.

The Jakobskreuz in St. Jakob

The Jakobskreuz on the Buchensteinwand stands at 1,456 meters above sea level. This cross-shaped structure is 29.6 meters tall and features a panoramic viewing platform at the top level (about 28 meters high), offering an incredible view of the Pillersee Valley. For rest and refreshment, the Alpine inn Buchensteinwand is also well worth a visit.



Pillersee

The Pillersee in St. Ulrich is captivating thanks to its idyllic location and emerald-green color! The many recreational opportunities around the lake are practically just a bonus: beautiful, relaxing panoramic trails, a Kneipp facility, pedal and rowboat rentals, fishing spots, a lakeside restaurant and bistro, and even an underwater observation area at the Forellennranch restaurant on the northern shore of the lake.
